



2024 "Rosaleda" Rosé of Tempranillo, Don Miguel Vineyard *Estate Grown, Estate Bottled*

Why "Rosaleda"?

Rosaleda means 'rose garden' in Spanish, and the name evokes the beautiful color of this rosé as well as the fragrant floral notes of this special vineyard.

Tempranillo is recognized as the finest red variety indigenous to Spain, so I decided to bring the cuttings over from Spain. After a decade of experimenting with it in our vineyard, we are thrilled with the results: our site is proving ideal for it to thrive, just like it does in the cool areas of Ribera del Duero and High Rioja of Northern Spain.

The Don Miguel Vineyard

Named after the late patriarch of the Torres family, this vineyard is located in the Green Valley — the coolest, foggiest region of the Russian River, only ten miles from the Pacific. The European-style high density of over 2,000 vines per acre provides low yields and requires intensive labor; but the vines live longer and the grapes acquire better balance and greater concentration, as well as more elegance and finesse than with the traditional low density.

The Vinification

The grapes were harvested October 30, gently whole-cluster pressed with a short time on the skins for gentle extraction of color and flavor, then cold fermented in stainless steel tanks at 55 degrees F. It was bottled in March 2025.

Tasting Notes

Light salmon color and elegant aromas reminiscent of rose petals, clementines and pomegranate. On the palate it is fresh and fruity, crisp and lively, with refreshing acidity that makes it easy to drink as an aperitif or with food and light dishes. I would recommend serving it at 46-48 F.
