

### 92 2014 Marimar Estate Albariño, Russian River Valley, Don Miguel Vineyard

What a triumph this is for Marimar Torres, who experimented with different appellations to grow Albariño before settling on the Russian River. Grown organically and planted at high density, the wine is made in steel and does not go through malolactic fermentation. It has an expressive, authentic and beguiling nose where the most delicate fresh pear and peach marries with gentle floral hints, and a touch of Chablis-like flint. A terrific Albariño by any standards. Only the 2012/2013 are in stock at the UK at time of review.




### 90 2014 Marimar Estate La Masia Chardonnay Russian River Valley, Don Miguel Vineyard

### 90 2014 Marimar Estate La Masia Chardonnay Russian River Valley, Don Miguel Vineyard



Clean and composed, tight yet fairly deep, mannerly, balanced and very much made in the carefully drafted style that Marimar has been delivering for years, this wine comes with a tad more richness than normal owing to the vineyard yet stays true to its last. It is supple to start, then firms up as expected, and while its blackberry and spice character follows through well, it will find fuller voice as the wine gains the added polish that is sure to come with cellar time.

### 93 2012 Marimar Estate Cristina Pinot Noir, Russian River Valley, Don Miguel Vineyard

What a superb, aromatic and perfumed Pinot this is from the Don Miguel Vineyard in the Russian River. Famed biodynamically, the vineyard is mostly planted with the Swan Pinot clone, with 30% Pomard, and 10% Dijon clones. This one is aged in French oak, 40% of which is new. The nose really is gorgeous, framing seductive berries, violet, and sweet exotic spice with some earth and woodland truffle notes, before a palate that ripples with cherry and sweet red fruit, an undertow of spice and chocolate, and smooth as silk tannins against the pretty acidity. Terrific and will probably age well for a decade.
