A unique trip to Northern Spain's top wineries & restaurants!



Itinerary

The trip will kick off on Wednesday, June 17 in Bilbao. Group transfer provided from there to the nearby city of San Sebastian, where we will stay 3 nights.

The trip ends on Saturday, June 27 in Santiago de Compostela, checking out from the famous Parador hotel in the morning.

Cost and Program Summary

Cost is \$9,500 per person. Includes full program for 10 days, transportation, breakfast and one main meal per day at top restaurants, guided tours, tips, etc. Price based on double occupancy; additional charge for singles. A \$1,000 non-refundable deposit per person is required to hold your reservation. Final payment is due February 1.

Schedule

Wednesday, 17 June: Group transportation from Bilbao airport to San Sebastian, in time for welcome dinner. Stay at Hotel M^a Cristina for 3 nights.

Thursday, 18 June: Guided tour of San Sebastian and lunch at Arzak, the oldest 3*Michelin restaurant in the city.

Friday, 19 June: Guided tour in Bilbao, visiting Guggenheim Museum. Lunch at Asador Etxebarri, 1* Michelin and rated 3rd among The World's 50 Best Restaurants in 2019.

Saturday, 20 June: Drive to La Rioja, visit and tasting at Familia Torres winery and other high-end wineries. Lunch at Asador José Mari and drive to Logroño, check-in at Fuerte Ruavieja Eurostars hotel for 2 nights.

Sunday, 21 June: Visit to Marqués de Riscal winery, lunch at their 1* Michelin Gastronomic Restaurant, and return for a tour in Logroño.

Monday, 22 June: Drive to Burgos, tour and visit to the Cathedral. Lunch in 1*Michelin Refectorio. Visits to Vega Sicilia and Familia Torres wineries in Ribera del Duero. Drive to Valladolid, check-in at Palacio de Santa Ana AC hotel for 2 nights.

Tuesday, 23 June: Drive to Rueda, where Familia Torres produces wines from the Verdejo variety. Drive to Segovia, lunch at 1*Michelin restaurant Villena and guided tour to this city, visiting the II Century Roman Aqueduct.

Wednesday 24 June: Drive to Galicia, the westernmost province in Spain, stopping for lunch at 1*Michelin El Capricho restaurant, and following to the Parador in Santiago de Compostela for 3 nights.

Thursday, 25 June: Visit and wine tasting at Pazo Torre Penelas, Familia Torres' estate in Rias Baixas, an old mansion from the XIV-XV Century where Familia Torres produces Albariño wines. Lunch at 1*Michelin Yayo Daporta, then guided tour in Santiago and visit to the famous Cathedral, dedicated to Apostle Santiago.

Friday, 26 June: Visit and tasting to renowned wineries in Rias Baixas. Drive to Coruña for lunch at 1*Michelin Arbore da Veira, with the best landscapes of the city. Guided tour and return to Santiago for the last night.

Saturday, 27 June: Departure from the hotel to the airport of Santiago de Compostela.
